

ACS SUPPLY LIST FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL 2026/2027 SCHOOL YEAR

**Students will need to replenish consumable supplies over the course of the year.
Students should have their names on all personal items.**

Personal Items – Bring labeled on the first day of school

- ☐ 2-Inch View Binder (replaces Trapper Keeper)
 - ☐ 8 Multi-Colored Tabs/Dividers with pockets
- ☐ Clear Pencil Box or Pouch
 - ☐ 2 packs of pencils for student
 - ☐ 1 set of coloring supplies (colored pencils, markers, or crayons)
 - ☐ 1 Colored pen (red, green, or purple)
 - ☐ Highlighters - 2 different colors
- ☐ 8th Grade: Composition notebook with graph paper
- ☐ 2 Composition books labeled for: ELA, Spanish

Classroom Supplies – Bring on Meet the Teacher to your child' s homeroom

- ☐ 1 pack of graph paper (for math classroom)
- ☐ 1 pack of loose leaf paper (for homeroom)
- ☐ 3 reams of copy paper
- ☐ Post-it notes
- ☐ 1 100-count package of 3x5 note cards
- ☐ 5th Grade: package of baby wipe refills
- ☐ 6th Grade: 2 rolls of paper towels
- ☐ 7th Grade: 1 pack of Clorox wipes
- ☐ 8th Grade: Expo Markers
- ☐ 2 boxes of tissues (for classroom)

Students are not permitted to use calculators in the 5th grade. If 6th–8th grade students wish to have their own personal calculator, any scientific calculator with a square root function is sufficient. Scientific calculators can be purchased for approximately \$10. If 8th grade students desire a graphing calculator, please check with the high school you plan on attending to determine the type of graphing calculator to purchase. They typically cost more than \$100. In class, we use the website Desmos for graphing capability. Desmos has equivalent functionality and is free.

We do not have a classroom set of calculators.
